- AWCA has the right to ask any student to leave the program based on their lack of effort, unwillingness to participate, and/or truancy.
- All students will be allowed only three (3) absences. This will be strictly enforced with the exception of medical emergencies.
- Class will begin at 10:00 am in the morning and 12:30 pm after lunch. Students will only be allowed a maximum of five (5) tardies for the duration of the program.
