Policies

- Only students who will be entering grades 9 through 12 in September 2019 are eligible for the program.
- New students are admitted on the basis of their application on a first come, first serve basis. Returning students will be placed on a waiting list and admitted only if there is availability after the close of the application process.
- Financial documentation of family income below 250% of the Federal Poverty Guideline is required to be eligible for free tuition. Students who do not meet this requirement will be offered admission to the program with tuition according to a sliding scale based on the family's income.
- A deposit of \$300 is required of all students at enrollment, which will be returned to the student at the end of the semester pending satisfactory adherence to all program requirements and policies.
- AWCA has the right to ask any student to leave the program based on their lack of effort, unwillingness to
 participate, and/or truancy. Any student asked to leave the program for these reasons forfeits their deposit.
- All students will be allowed only three (3) absences. This will be strictly enforced with the exception of medical emergencies. Students must provide an official letter signed by a parent or guardian to the program coordinator detailing the date(s) and reason(s) for the absence. Failure to comply will result in forfeiture of the deposit.
- A strict homework policy will be enforced. It is the responsibility of the student to make sure each day's assignments are completed thoroughly and on time. Failure to comply will result in the forfeiture of the deposit.
- Students who are tardy more than three (3) times will forfeit the deposit.

Acknowledgement of Commitment & Responsibilities

I would like to enroll in the 2019 AWCA SAT Scholarship Class. I understand the requirements pertaining to my enrollment and will uphold the code of ethics required of me. As part of my duties and responsibilities as a student, I understand that I am required to be on time, maintain proper behavior as a student, and uphold the attendance policy.
