Who We Are

AWCA was founded in 1980 as a "Housewives Club" in Franklin Lakes, NJ by women of Christian faith. In 1983, it became the Lily Club of the YWCA based in Montclair, NJ. By June of 1987, the organization grew to 32 members and was renamed the New Jersey Korean YWCA. YWCA was born out of a sincere desire shared by a group of Korean immigrant women to contribute to the improvement of their newfound community.

In July 2000, the New Jersey Korean YWCA changed its name to Asian Women's Christian Association, and it was incorporated as a 501(c) 3 nonprofit organization to reflect the broadening of its philanthropic activities to the local community in the tristate area.

To date, the Asian Women's Christian Association (AWCA) is a 501(c) (3) nonprofit social service agency located in Teaneck, NJ. This year, AWCA celebrates its 40th year of service to the community according to its mission statement:

AWCA (Asian Women's Christian Association), centered on the love of Christ, provides families with the resources to become healthy, contributing members of society through education, social, and homecare services.

AWCA prepared and delivered Covid-19 Relief Angel Food Baskets for people in need affected by the quarantine due to Covid-19. This might be the first response to the food relief drive for the Covid-19 pandemic in New Jersey. This ministry was made possible by gifts from various individual donors, public organizations - such as KACF, KAAG, 21 Hope Foundation, etc. - and volunteers for delivery.

Social Service

The AWCA Social Service Program is designed to introduce the various social welfare systems and programs offered by the US government and to inform and assist people according to their individual circumstances. The purpose of this program is to promote the well-being of individuals living in the United States and support them with access to resources to live as healthy, contributing, self-sufficient members of the community and society.

This welfare service is a free, public program that aims to provide a wide range of information about social services and benefits within the United States. Currently, AWCA has ten certified counselors (Korean, Japanese, and Chinese) including one supervisor. AWCA's services are open to anyone by walk-in, appointment, and phone in their native languages. Social Welfare Service Seminars and continuing education on Outreach Volunteers are offered four times a year.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the state government of New Jersey issued an official order for all businesses

to close temporarily in March. During this time, AWCA employees began working from home and started an online-only COVID-19 Helpline, operating from 9AM to 12AM, Monday through Friday. Through social networking platforms such as the Korean app (Kakao), Chinese app (WeChat) and Japanese app (Line), AWCA members provided coronavirus related news updates as well as social welfare counseling services in each respective language. This year, AWCA helped with almost double the information assistance cases compared to this same period last year.

In addition, free legal consultation is offered twice a month (2nd and 4th Tuesdays) for low-income families in New Jersey who urgently need legal services. This consultation is provided by Lawyer Will Kang, ESQ.



2020 SAT & ACT Scholarship Class Opening

- Online Intensive Course

Again this year, with a generous donation sponsored by the Grace Charity Foundation, AWCA partnered with Prestige Institute to offer online SAT & ACT scholarship classes. The 2020 SAT & ACT Scholarship Class ran from July 6 to August 14 as a six week, 120 hour intensive online course in response to COVID-19. Zoom classes began at 9:00 AM until 2:30 PM, Monday through Friday, covering reading, writing, math and science lessons, practice tests on alternating days and follow-up review and discussion.

AWCA offered a full scholarship program to a total of 15 high school students in grades 10, 11, and 12 in New York, New Jersey, and Illinois. The SAT & ACT Scholarship Class is a program purposed on educating and encouraging motivated but financially disadvantaged young students to enhance and excel in test prep skills and academics during the summer vacation. The Prestige Institute provided educational services, test prep materials, and teaching staff. Shelby Kim and Ellie Chung served as Volunteer Teaching Assistants for AWCA.



Students were required prior enrollment to complete and submit an application form, essay writing, household income tax copy attached survey, and a deposit of \$300 to be returned in full pending satisfactory completion of the program. Every student received either full or partial scholarships, but free tuition was offered to every eligible student.

I am very grateful for the opportunity that AWCA has given me despite the fact that I was away from New Jersey and my close friends and family members during summer vacation; I was worried about how to find assistance financially with my SAT prep. The AWCA SAT & ACT Scholarship Course is an amazing program that gives students the opportunity to learn and improve together. Since I was not able to physically attend classes, I was able to receive the help that I needed through the online Zoom classes. Even though online classes proved to have some

difficulties compared to meeting in person, the teaching staff was extremely well prepared and made the process of online learning easy. In my personal experience, the teachers and teaching assistants were caring, accepting, patient and kind. Thanks to their dedication, I am happy to say that my SAT score has improved significantly after the six week program. It was also a great opportunity to connect with fellow high school students in different districts and establish relationships with my mentors and peers. As someone who lived in Chicago, Illinois at the time and was in no way obligated to join the program, I feel blessed and thankful to God to have had the opportunity to be accepted into the program. Thanks to Prestige Institute and AWCA for the rewarding experience of gaining higher education! If given the chance, I would love to participate in this SAT summer class once more.

Eighteen years ago, the AWCA Home Care was the first agency of its kind in the northeast region to be established within a Korean organization. The program first began with eight patients under its care and has since grown to serve 315 patients through the care and expertise of 171 certified home health aides (CHHA). In 2006, the program expanded by establishing its Chinese department, thereby becoming a homecare program for the Asian community. The program continues to show continued progress and advancement to this day.

During the COVID-19 Pandemic

- 1. Due to COVID-19, the 58th Home Care Aide Training session in April was canceled. Even though many prospective participants inquired about the session, the training was canceled in compliance with the administrative order of the state government of New Jersey.
- 2. In-service training was modified into Self-Study.
- 3. For better patient care, PPE materials were provided to all the Home Care participants.

Home Health Aide Education

In 2004, AWCA Home Care was certified by the government of New Jersey to provide home health aide certification training. Since then, the AWCA Homecare program has trained and certified over 545 CHHAs. The certification program is provided in both Korean and Chinese and requires a total of 76 hours of training. After successfully completing the course, trainees must pass a qualifying exam, which is also offered in both Korean and Chinese. CHHA training is provided quarterly each year and takes place over the span of two weeks.









Finally, AWCA Home Care sincerely appreciates all of our Home Health Aide employees and staff for their utmost caregiving.



Social Welfare Radio Broadcast

"Finding Happiness with AWCA"

AWCA is the first non-profit organization to launch its own radio broadcast four years ago. The purpose of the program was to spread out the services provided by AWCA to those who cannot access such benefits due to time and travel constraints. Since the year of 2018, we started a series of weekly broadcasts to focus on social welfare service. People living in New York and New Jersey have enjoyed listening to the radio broadcasting, visited AWCA for consultations, and received practical aid.

Especially during the height of COVID-19, we wanted to provide a resource for people to help ease the physical, mental and emotional distress caused by the global pandemic. We also addressed these novel day to day issues with assistance and care through the radio broadcast.

Every Saturday morning from 8:30 am to 9:00 am, we receive consultation request letters from listeners and work to solve their problems together. In the span of 52 weeks, 130 counseling cases were covered, and 320 people called AWCA through the radio broadcasting channel for specific answers. AWCA will continue to provide its social services through the broadcast and through in-person office appointments and by phone consultation from Monday to Friday, 9AM to 5PM.

The broadcast effectively brings AWCA's Social service programs into the homes of people living in New York/ New Jersey to help them manage heathy and happy lives.

In Loving Memory of Kihwa Kwak



This year, many of our loved ones have left us due to the COVID-19 global pandemic. AWCA also experienced the significant loss of Ms. Kihwa Kwak, our beloved friend, supporter, volunteer, and generous donor and founder of the Ki Hwa Scholarship.

Born March 10, 1934, the late Ms. Kwak worked as a registered nurse with 40 years of service. With all of the money she saved in her lifetime, she established the Kihwa Scholarship through AWCA 17 years ago to encourage and support notable students from financially disadvantaged backgrounds. Her mission was to subsidize the tuition of college and graduate students who experience financial difficulties in their studies.

Every year, AWCA's Kihwa Scholarship Committee selects two final recipients for the Kihwa Scholarship Award. The two students are awarded \$3,000 each, \$6,000 in total. Counting 2020, a total amount of \$102,000 scholarship has been awarded to 34 recipients.

After the late Ms. Kwak retired, she actively served at AWCA. In addition to numerous volunteer services, she

focused on nurturing and training home health aides at AWCA Home Care.

This past Mother's Day Sunday, May 10th, 2020, Ms. Kwak passed away due to coronavirus. The donor of the Kihwa Scholarship may no longer be here with us, but her love and spirit of service will remain forever in our hearts. AWCA will continue to honor her legacy and remember the will of the late Ms. Kihwa Kwak through the scholarship award.

2020 Kihwa Scholarship Awards

On September 12, AWCA selected two applicants, Ms. Pearl Parker, Cooper Medical School of Rowan University and Mr. Charles Kim, NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine, for the AWCA 2020 Kihwa Scholarship Award in the amount of \$3,000 to each recipient. Every year, AWCA selects two final recipients for the Kihwa Scholarship Award.

Pearl Parker, 2020 Kihwa Scholarship Recipient

Hi! My name is Pearl Parker. I am a first-year medical student at Cooper Medical School in Camden, NJ and I was the fortunate recipient of the AWCA Kihwa Scholarship Award for 2020. I am continually grateful for the AWCA scholarship as it has lightened my financial burden and has allowed me to focus my energy on learning and serving the community around me.

I am actively involved with two service programs at my school called Street Medicine and Homework Heroes. In Street Medicine, we provide outreach, support, supplies, and basic medical care to unsheltered individuals. It has been a humbling experience to walk through homeless encampments and be a part of making someone's day a little brighter by fulfilling even the simplest of requests like providing a handwarmer. This has been the bigger impact of AWCA's scholarship on my life and also the lives I hope to positively impact through my service.

2020 Census Report

In early October 2019, AWCA was designated as the official 2020 Census Public Outreach and Promoting Agency and received grants from the New Jersey State's Census 2020 Committee. Among 52 grantee organizations in NJ and 3 in Bergen County, AWCA was the only Asian-American nonprofit organization. From October 2019 to October 2020, AWCA headed the 2020 Census Project to promote the importance of the census counts and response to the community as follows:

1) Before the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic

- (1) Organizing LCCC (Jan 2): We organized LCCC (CCC AWCA) and joined LCCC (Bergen County) and CCC NJ to communicate and share information related to the census from A to Z.
- (2) 2020 Census Solution Workshop (Jan 29-31): For three days with the help of Barbara Brown (CENSUS/NY FED), AWCA Census Project Director Crane Kim hosted and led the census workshop for three language groups respectively. (25 volunteers; 105 participants)
- (3) Census Job Fairs (9 times): AWCA invited Mr. Kenneth Kim and his team from the US Census 2020 Recruiting Team to recruit census takers from Korean, Japanese, and Chinese volunteers.
- (4) Seminars on 2020 Census (8 times): CCC AWCA educated senior members (Korean, Japanese and Chinese) about the census.
- (5) AWCA Census Kick-Off Ceremony (Feb 17): AWCA invited key local figures in the census campaign including Bergen County Freeholder

- Germaine Ortiz, President of Korean American Census Task Force Mr. Andrew Kim, and seven other speakers, Board of Directors, and Korean, Chinese, and Japanese senior volunteers. (40 guests)
- **(6) Census Kiosk (Feb 17):** We launched four key kiosks in three different languages.
- (7) Volunteer Training (Feb. 25, 26, 27): AWCA educated volunteers (Korean 20; Japanese 5; Chinese 9) about census information and how to encourage the participation in kiosks and other public places.
- **(8) Census Outreach Seminars (Feb-March):** During this period, AWCA visited and gave some lectures on the importance of the census and distributed flyers, posters, census manuals, and promotional gifts.
- (9) Census Outreach Visitations (March 3 -21): Visited 21 local churches, 7 public libraries, 4 community centers, and 5 shopping centers. (Distributed AWCA Census Brochure 3100 copies (Korean 8500 + Chinese 2500 + Japanese 2300); 30 copies of Census 2020 Posters; 2000 Census Pledge forms; Census Promotional gifts (3500 Key chain whistles/ 650 Shopping bags/ 1500 Hand sanitizers 1500/1500 Census badges 'I Counted', etc.)



- (10) Online Outreach: Started census promotion through our homepage, email blasts, and SNS tools (Kakaotalk, Wechat, Line), and opened a Twitter, Facebook, and Youtube account. We had some technical assistance in filming and editing of our official census video from the Englewood Hospital technical team.
- (11) **Broadcasting Outreach:** Happiness with AWCA (30 minute program once a week at AM 1660 Radio Korea Broadcast)



2) After Covid-19 Quarantine (Since March 16-June 21)

- (1) Phone Banking (March-June): "Tell the census to more than 5 people" (At least 966 Calls)
- (2) Email blasts: Sending out letters about Census (9); Angel Baskets (3); Covid-19 & Census (5)

Nine years have passed since I completed volunteer training at the AWCA Family Counseling Center in 2011. I am grateful and pleased that I have been able to serve with others who share a common interest in the beneficial and informative work here. I am especially glad that I am able to help others by studying various topics, such as Mental Health, Suicide Prevention, Child Abuse and Neglect, and Dementia Prevention. The devastating COVID-19 Pandemic began paralyzing our community and daily lives little by little since mid-March, making spring, summer, and autumn feel like early winter.

On February 17, AWCA launched the 2020 Census Kickoff Ceremony under the slogan, "Serving for the Future," with the task team of volunteers. In the months following, we participated in census outreach events in Bergen County. I could personally feel the anxiety caused by the coronavirus at these events, which made it difficult to approach people. However, AWCA staff and volunteers pushed hard to promote the importance of the census and encourage participation. Through our dedicated efforts, fortunately, AWCA reached its desired 99.9% total response rate by the census deadline, which leads me to believe that even the smallest amount of service is still very valuable.

Out of all the places I volunteered, the one that impressed me the most was the last outreach event at the Englewood Health Department for the Free Drive Thru Flu Shot Clinic. Witnessing the overflow of vehicles that lined up for assistance, I felt very proud to be of active service working alongside the nurses and helping in any way I could. 
