Policies

- Only students who will be entering grades 11 through 12 in September 2021 are eligible for the program.
- New students are admitted on the basis of their application on a first come, first serve basis. Returning students will be placed on a waiting list and admitted only if there is availability after the close of the application process.
- Financial documentation of family income below 250% of the Federal Poverty Guideline is required to be eligible for free tuition. Students who do not meet this requirement will be offered admission to the program with tuition according to a sliding scale based on the family's income.
- A deposit of \$300 is required of all students at enrollment, which will be returned to the student at the end of the semester pending satisfactory adherence to all program requirements and policies.
- AWCA has the right to ask any student to leave the program based on their lack of effort, unwillingness to participate, and/or truancy. Any student asked to leave the program for these reasons forfeits their deposit.
- All students will be allowed only three (3) absences. This will be strictly enforced with the exception of medical emergencies. Students must provide an official letter signed by a parent or guardian to the program coordinator detailing the date(s) and reason(s) for the absence. Failure to comply will result in forfeiture of the deposit.
- A strict homework policy will be enforced. It is the responsibility of the student to make sure each day's assignments are completed thoroughly and on time. Failure to comply will result in the forfeiture of the deposit.
- Students who are tardy more than three (3) times will forfeit the deposit.

 - **Tell us about a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you? What did you learn from the experience?**
 - **Where do you see yourself in ten years? What do you see yourself doing? What steps are you taking to help you reach that goal?**
4. Please send the complete application to **info@awcanj.org**, or to **AWCA, 9 Genesee Ave. Teaneck, NJ 07666** by **Friday, June 25, 2021**. Acceptance decisions will be sent out via email to the applicant, along with a welcome packet detailing all program policies and requirements.
5. Enrollment for accepted applicants will only be complete upon receipt of the enrollment deposit of \$300. This deposit will be returned in full to the student at the end of the program pending satisfactory adherence to all program policies and requirements. **Please do NOT send any deposit unless confirmation of acceptance into the program is received.** Additional details will be provided with the welcome packet.
