HOME CARE NEWS

The Second Half of 2022

- 1. October Self-study homework for the 3rd In Service Training was delivered to all home health aides. Topics included in this homework were on elder abuse, child abuse, domestic violence, and human trafficking awareness. Medical knowledge that are essential for patient care from online and YouTube resources were utilized in both Korean and Chinese to train home health aides.
- **2. October** The 61st CHHA Training Korean Class took place for 2 weeks, from October 17th to 28th.



3. December - The 4th In Service Training class was replaced with online self-study homework. Homework topics included 'Alzheimer's and Dementia Awareness', 'Pain Management', and Hospice. Materials including quizzes for each topic were translated into Korean and Chinese and were delivered to all home health aides.

The First Half of 2023

- **1.** CAHC annual audit took place on February 8th. After reviewing documents for all patients and home health aides the audit confirmed that AWCA Home Care Agency's services and operation were in compliance with state regulations.
- **2.** The 62nd CHHA Training Class provided 76 hours of training for 2 weeks, from March 13th to 24th.



3. The 1st In Service Training of 2023 was conducted via self-study in March. The 2nd In Service Training was conducted inperson in conjunction with Competency Class. This week-long training, which was divided into 6 classes by hour and day, was carried out in an enjoyable and lively mood due to colleagues who have been seeing each other for the first time in a while due to COVID-19.


